



PADI Dry Suit SPECIALTY

COURSE OVERVIEW

Brisbane winters offers some of the most amazing diving around Moreton Bay. In winter, the visibility is better and there are less divers crowding the dive sites. The only drawback – colder water. A dry suit takes away the barrier to diving in winter and opens up many cold water dive sites around the world.

With a dry suit you have seals on the wrists and neck, with fully enclosed feet. This means you can do the "James Bond" and wear whatever you like underneath - because you stay dry! Imagine the difference when you return to shore, take off your dry suit and you're instantly ready to jump in the car and drive away!

As with any new piece of equipment, a dry suit requires training and practice. A low-pressure inflator hose connects your dry suit to your regulator, enabling you to put air into the suit to counteract the "squeeze" when you descend. A PADI Dry Suit Course covers the use of this equipment plus general training on hazard management, such as - "what happens when I go upside down and all the air goes into my feet?"

PREREQUISITES

- PADI Junior Open Water
- Minimum age 12 years
- Dive Equipment (rental equipment available for hire)

COURSE DETAILS

The Dry Suit Diver Speciality course is completed over two days. Dive World can facilitate personalised courses which can be scheduled to suit individual needs.

On your Dry Suit Diver course you will learn about:

- Organisation, procedures, techniques, problems and hazards of dry suit diving
- Routine user-level preventative maintenance and performance checks on dry suits
- Proper procedures for buoyancy control
- Ascent and descent technique training

That's it! After day two you will be certified to stay dry while diving.
