## OVERVIEW

The two courses, Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR) and Emergency First Response Secondary Care (First Aid), make up a foundational offering in emergency care for the lay provider. Within the two courses, CPR and first aid skills are integrated into an easy-to-remember emergency care sequence. This sequence allows participants to provide effective emergency care to injured or ill persons.
