



# PADI Scuba Diver Course

*Learning to dive is easy and lots of fun*

## PREREQUISITES

- You need to be comfortable in the water and have some basic swimming skills.
- The minimum age for scuba certification is 12 years old for the Junior Scuba Diver certification (adult-supervised diving) and 15 years old for the Scuba Diver certification.
- In Queensland, you are required to obtain an approved Scuba Diving Medical Certificate prior to commencing this course. A list of medical practitioners who offer this medical can be found on the Dive World website.

## COURSE DETAILS

The Scuba Diver course is completed over 2.5 days. Usually this is one part day for theory and two days practical (confined and open water dives). Dive World can facilitate personalised courses which can be scheduled to suit individual needs.

**Day 1** (part day) - You will spend today in the classroom going over the knowledge reviews that you completed at home, and learning the basic concepts you need to keep you safe when scuba diving. Your instructor will make sure you have the required level of knowledge in order to continue with your training.

**Days 2 & 3** - It is time to put on the scuba gear! You spend the next two days doing a combination of pool (confined water) and ocean (open water) dives to complete your course.

That's it! Then you will be certified to dive up to 12 metres with a PADI Professional *anywhere in the world!* If you want to continue your training from here, it's time to go on to the **PADI Open Water Course**, where you can dive up to 18m with a buddy.

## FAST TRACK THE TRAINING

Want to fast track the training? Ask us about how you can complete your theory online directly through PADI e-learning and cut out the classroom training (Day 1). If you choose this option you will need to pay PADI directly to use their online training facility.
